

Harmony Horsemanship Clinic with Lindsey Partridge Registration Form

Advancing Liberty for May 27-28, 2017

Find your calm connection through Liberty at Partridge Horse Hill, Pontypool, Ontario.

Lindsey Partridge is an expert at training and retraining horses to help them find a calm connection with their human. She helps horses and riders find relaxation and harmony together so they are better able to succeed at whatever their goal is – trail riding, competitive jumping, obstacles, etc.

The goal of Harmony Horsemanship is to understand yourself, your horse and the language that connects you.

Lindsey is the first trainer to win two disciplines at the International Retired Racehorse Project's Thoroughbred Makeover, and first trainer to have both her horses qualify for finals (top 3) in both of their disciplines which included Trail, Freestyle, and Field Hunter.

This clinic will focus on liberty – how to get your horse to want to stick with you, connect with you, and have fun at liberty. We will start online and progress to liberty.

Note the agenda is the same for each day, and the exercises and learning will progress each day.

Agenda:

8:30am – 9:45am – welcome, introductions, and classroom learning: what are your horse's A, B, C's? why does that matter when playing at liberty? The phases of the Harmony Training Continuum - which phases you can practice at liberty(respect & safety, calm connection, create a yes horse, and refinement), and how can we increase the calm connection so your horse wants to stick with you.

9:45am-10am: break

10am – 12:30pm – Ground Work. Trying ground exercises to help you improve your calm connection and create more positive flexion and draw with your horse.

12:30pm – 1:30pm: lunch time and a chance to ask any questions about the morning

1:30pm- 4:30pm Putting Liberty to the Test: challenge yourself with these exercises to test your connection, we will also have some 'classroom' discussion with question & answer while our horses hang out with us so we can allow more soak time for the horses (or fidgety horses can go in the round pen for this part). Depending on the group needs we may do 10-15min of private sessions in the round pen.

5pm – 6pm: Optional watch Lindsey work with her horses

- You can transfer your clinic spot to another suitable participant and receive a full refund less a \$15 admin fee at any time. Note if your horse becomes injured and is not able to participate, but you still want to, we will provide a Partridge Horse Hill lesson horse at no charge.
- Please check in to registration by 8:30am on the day of the clinic.
- Please bring a rope halter, lead rope (preferably 12-14ft yacht type rope), and horsemen's stick & string for ground work (dressage whip also works).
- Park in designated areas only
- Please clean up after yourself and your horse.
- Rented stalls/paddocks need to be mucked out after use
- The clinic will be held indoors as needed.
- All participants are responsible for their own safety and the safety of their horse.
- Partridge Horse Hill, Lindsey Partridge, the host facility, staff, volunteers, family and friends are not responsible for lost or damaged equipment. Please be responsible for your belongings.
- You will need to complete a liability waiver for the host facility and Lindsey Partridge. You will also need to complete a social media form.
